**3 to 1** voters prefer a bipartisan commission over a single director.

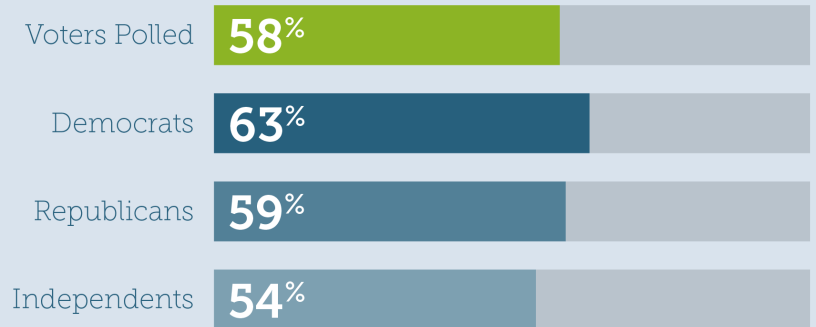


**A majority** of voters believe a commission would help consumers and small business.
